2006 SUMMER FELLOWSHIPS

The Electrochemical Society is pleased announce it is accepting applications for The Electrochemical Society Summer Fellowships for the summer of 2006. The purpose of these Fellowships is to assist students in continuing graduate work during the summer months in a field of interest to The Electrochemical Society. There will be 4 Summer fellowships awarded totaling \$16,000. The fellowships will be called the Edward G. Weston Fellowship, the Colin Garfield Fink Fellowship, the Joseph W. Richards Fellowship, and the F.M. Becket Fellowship, with each fellowship amounting to \$4,000.

Fellowships will be awarded without regard to sex, citizenship, race or financial need. They will be made to a graduate student pursuing work between the degrees of B.S. and Ph.D. in a college or university, and who will continue their studies after the summer period. A previous holder of an award is eligible for reappointment. It is the intention of this award that the student becomes solely an Electrochemical Society Summer Fellow; therefore, the student is required not to accept or receive other substantial financial support during this time period. Successful recipients of Fellowships shall agree not to hold other appointments or other Fellowships during the summer of 2005.

Applicants must complete an application form in PDF format and supply the following information:

1. A brief statement of educational objectives for the summer of 2006 – no longer than 0.5 page, single spaced, 12-pt Times New Roman.
2. A brief statement of the thesis research problem including objectives, work already accomplished, and work planned for the summer of 2006 objectives – no longer than 4 pages, single spaced, 12-pt Times New Roman. Figures should be embedded in the text.
For items 1 and 2, the applicant must submit them as PDF documents.
3. A transcript of undergraduate and graduate academic work.
4. Two letters of recommendation, one of which should be from the applicant's research adviser.
